SUBJECT

ECT : AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT AND PARTICIPATE IN THE FIELD PROGRAMS OPERATIONAL PLANNING DIVISION (FPOPD) MID-YEAR ASSESSMENT AND PLANNING WORKSHOP

The Field Programs Operational Planning Division (FPOPD), under the Department's Field Operations Service (FOS), is mandated to translate into realistic commodity operational plans and program guidelines the strategic plans of the Department, provide operational policy framework in the implementation of commodity programs and disaster/climate risk reduction and management activities (DRRM), develop and maintain the GIS-based Disaster/Climate Risk Reduction and Management Information System (DRRMIS) and the Operations Management Information System (O-MIS), and develop the operational plans and guidelines on DRRM activities.

The Division, composed of 19 plantilla positions, also handles two of the Department's Banner Programs, Rice and Corn Programs. These commodity programs hire its personnel/Job Orders to perform various specific tasks. There is also the DA Rehabilitation and Recovery Project Support Office (RRPSO) which oversees all rehabilitation and recovery activities and monitors the implementation and accomplishment.

As per Civil Service Commission, each Office is required to submit the Office Performance Commitment and Review (OPCR) and each personnel must submit the Individual Performance Commitment Review (IPCR). Given the number of staff the FPOPD employs and the schedule of each Section/unit under the Division, there is a need to conduct a Division-wide workshop to finalize the above mentioned requirements.

Thus, a mid-year assessment and planning workshop shall be conducted on June 24 - 28, 2024 in Region IV-A. The workshop shall also cover a Complete Staff Work Training as part of capacitating DA FPOPD personnel for a more efficient day-to-day office operations.


