SUBJECT: AUTHORITY TO ORGANIZE AND PARTICIPATE IN TRAINING ON GOOD HYGIENIC SLAUGHTERING PRACTICES (GHSP) AS PART OF THE ACTIVITIES OF RESEARCH PROJECT

In the interest of service and as part of the activities of the research project titled "Microbiological Assessment and Inspection of Hog Slaughterhouses in Support of the Implementation of Good Hygienic Slaughtering Practices (GHSP)," the Food Development Center (FDC) is hereby authorized to organize a two-day training on GHSP in hogs on June 24-25, 2024 to be facilitated by the Bureau of Animal Industry - Animal Products Development Center (BAI-APDC) as resource speakers.

The training aims for participants (slaughterhouse operators, LGU inspectors, and technical personnel) to acquire knowledge and develop skills that are essential in ensuring the safety and hygiene of the slaughterhouse and the food safety of the meat.
