The Investment Permanent and Alternate Focal Persons shall have the following roles and responsibilities:


1. Serve as the primary point of contact for all internal and external stakeholders regarding investment matters.
2. Develop and maintain partnership between government agencies, investors, and other key partners in relation to agribusiness investment promotion activities and develop and maintain partnerships with industry associations, financial institutions, and international organizations to support investment initiatives.
3. Facilitate preparation of IEC materials (i.e. commodity profiles, investment concepts, etc.) for promotions.
4. Participate and conduct local and international investment promotion events, in coordination with Agribusiness Investment Promotion Division of the Agribusiness and Marketing Assistance Service (AIPD-AMAS), concerned government and private investment promotion units.
5. Facilitate the conduct of Regional consultation on the preparation of Regional Commodity Agribusiness Investment Plans and related activities.
6. Prepare Regional Investment Programs, Projects and Activities to support the Regional Investment Promotion.
7. Respond to investor inquiries and provide comprehensive information/guidance about investment opportunities.
