SPECIAL ORDER No. 1802 Series of 2024

SUBJECT: AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT AND ATTEND THE HIGH SEAS BOARDING AND INSPECTION (HSBI) TRAINING FOR FISHERIES LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS ON NOVEMBER 24-29, 2024

In the interest of service, the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources—Fisheries Resources and Management Division—through the Conservation and Environmental Protection Section (BFAR FMRD-CEPS) in partnership with Department of Fisheries and Oceans (DFO) Canada is hereby authorized to conduct the *"High Seas Boarding and Inspection (HSBI) Training for Fisheries Law Enforcement Officers"* on November 24-29, 2024 (inclusive of travel time), in General Santos City, Region XII, and vicinities.

The aforementioned activity aims to:

- 1. Develop Legal and Operational Expertise: Equip officers with detailed knowledge of international fisheries laws, such as UNCLOS and WCPFC regulations.
- 2. Enhance Technical Competencies: Provide hands-on training in safe and effective boarding and inspection techniques, including fish identification, vessel documentation, and evidence collection.
- 3. Promote International Cooperation: Prepare officers to coordinate with other flag states and fisheries enforcement bodies globally.
- 4. Formalize the Qualification Process: Grant successful trainees the legal authority to conduct high seas inspections and boarding operations, signified by a qualification tab on their uniforms.
