## MEMORANDUM ORDER

No. 01

**SUBJECT : TEMPORARY BAN ON THE IMPORTATION OF DOMESTIC AND WILD BIRDS AND THEIR PRODUCTS INCLUDING POULTRY MEAT, DAY-OLD CHICKS, EGGS AND SEMEN ORIGINATING FROM *New Zealand***

**WHEREAS**, Book IV Chapter 2 Section 6 and 7 (2) and (4) of Executive Order no. 292, s. 1987 provides the authority and responsibility for the exercise of the mandate of the Department and for the discharge of its powers and functions vested in the Secretary, who shall have supervision and control of the Department, to establish the policies and standards for the operation of the Department pursuant to the approved programs of government and promulgate administrative issuances necessary for the efficient administration of the offices under the Secretary and the proper execution of the laws relative thereto;

**WHEREAS**, Section 1770 of Act No. 2711 (Revised Administrative Code of 1917) which was adopted by incorporation together with Sections 1761-1769, in Section 5 of Act 3639 (Charter of BAI) empower the Department Head to issue a general order preventing the entry of animals, animal effects, parts or products from any country with dangerous communicable animal disease;

**WHEREAS**, based on the official report submitted by Dr. Mary Van Anandel, Council member – Chief Veterinary Officer, Ministry for Primary Industries, *New Zealand* to the World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH) on 02 December 2024, there was an outbreak of H7N6 High Pathogenicity Avian Influenza in *East Otago, Waitaki, Canterbury, New Zealand* last 23 November 2024 affecting Domestic Birds as confirmed by New Zealand National Animal Health Laboratory.

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to prevent the entry of HPAI virus to protect the health of the local poultry population;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, **FRANCISCO P. TIU LAUREL JR.**, Secretary of the Department of Agriculture, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby institute the following emergency measures for the importation of domestic and wild birds and their products from *New Zealand*;

1. Banning the importation of domestic and wild birds and their products, including poultry meat, day old chicks, eggs and semen;

2. Immediate suspension of the processing, evaluation of the application and issuance of Sanitary and Phytosanitary (SPS) import clearance to the above stated commodities;

3. All shipments coming from *New Zealand* that are IN TRANSIT/LOADED/ACCEPTED UNTO PORT before the official communication of this Order to the *New Zealand* authorities shall be allowed provided that the products were slaughtered/produced on or before 09 November 2024.

4. Shipments which have not complied with the conditions set forth in Item 3 shall be dealt with as per DA AC 06 S. 2022 Article V, Section II. E.;

5. Stoppage and confiscation of all shipments of the above-stated commodities (with the exception of heat-treated products<sup>1</sup>) into the country by all Veterinary Quarantine Officers/Inspectors at all major ports of entry.

This **ORDER** shall take effect immediately and shall remain enforced unless revoked in writing. All orders inconsistent herewith are deemed revoked.

<sup>1</sup> Heat-Treated product are acceptable following Chapter 10.4 of the WOHAI Terrestrial Animal Health Code of 2019 provided that in addition to the Veterinary Health Certificate (VHC), the competent authority will include in the certification the following:

1. Temperature and duration of heating or pasteurization of products; and
2. There is no commingling of raw materials with any other materials of animal origin
