The **Members** shall perform the following functions, duties, and responsibilities inherent to their designation, such as, but not limited to:

- 1. Develop technical guidelines, policies, and recommendations for the prevention and control of Q Fever and other important ruminant diseases for the approval of the Secretary:
- 2. Provide technical expertise in the conduct of surveillance, monitoring, and other related activities to these diseases;
- 3. Coordinate with relevant stakeholders, both local and international, for technical assistance and resource mobilization;

- 4. Submit regular reports and recommendations to the DA Office of the Secretary for appropriate action and decision-making;
- 5. Conduct regular reviews of reports on Q Fever and other important ruminant diseases on the management measures and strategies aligned with existing local and international guidelines;
- 6. Designate one (1) technical representative who shall actively participate in the meetings, workshops, consultations, and other related activities together with the TWG Chairperson; and
- 7. Convene regular and/or emergency meetings when deemed necessary.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force unless revoked in writing. All other orders, memoranda, and issuances inconsistent herewith are deemed revoked.
