SUBJECT: AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT AND ATTEND THE TRAINING ON BIODYNAMIC SYSTEMS

In the interest of service and to promote sustainable and integrated farming practices, the Department of Agriculture - National Organic Agriculture Program (NOAP) is hereby authorized to conduct the Training on Biodynamic Systems on March 10-14, 2025 in Region III.

This training aims to familiarize NOAP program implementers with biodynamic farming principles, enhancing their capacity to improve soil health, farm productivity, and ecological balance. Specifically, the training seeks to:

- 1. Introduce good organic farming practices, integrating livestock and agroforestry for holistic farm management;
- 2. Introduce biodynamic farming principles and preparations;
- 3. Equip participants with practical skills in biodynamic preparations;
- 4. Introduce biodynamic certification and standards; and
- 5. Promote techniques that enhance soil fertility, biodiversity, and overall farm sustainability.
